AIRC is a non-profit standards development organization recognized by the U.S. Department of Justice, the U.S. Commercial Service.

The AIRC Certification process for agencies is rigorous and AIRC Certified agencies must meet the following criteria in order to be certified by AIRC:


- Eligibility rules for years in business and numbers of students placed
- No fraudulent activity as verified by a high-level background screening report (Foreign Corrupt Practices Report, which checks the company, multiple owner, native language, social media, legal liabilities and 200 anti-corruption indexes.)
- Verified documentation that the 40 requirements of the five AIRC Standards are met by the agency in its headquarters and any branches. A trained site reviewer visits the agency to verify the agency's documentation. An independent Certification Commission also conducts a comprehensive review of the agency. The AIRC standards fall under 5 general areas to ensure the agency meets criteria for planning and organization, sustainability, transparency around fees and recruitment processes, human resource policies, training of counseling staff on institutional partners and U.S. higher education, accreditation and immigration, truth and honesty in marketing, truthfulness in potential placement outcomes, confidentiality, authenticity of documentation, continued client evaluation and complaints process.
- High satisfaction as verified through multiple institutional partner references.
- Verified training of the agency's sub-agency partners (Recruitment Partners)
- An open comments and complaints process for the period within which the agency is approved to proceed through certification and for the period the agency is certified.

Global Education Services was awarded AIRC Certification in 2025 through 2030.

AIRC has received no complaints or negative comments pertaining to the services or processes of Global Education Services or through the references obtained through certification.
